- Girls' soccer scholarship application process – booster club will review the application used by the boys' soccer program, a committee of booster club members will review the application process and determine the scholarship recipient.
- April player/parent meeting
 - 3D patch options (add Rosemount Relay for Life participation)
 - Team options – 9th grade players will be able to make a team other than the 9th grade team.
 - \$20 Uniform fee will be charged per player whether or not a player needs socks
 - Fundraising Opportunities (wreath sales, car wash)
- Members present suggested getting an Irish Girls' Soccer Banner (M. Kelly-Carroll will check with Coach Floersch to find out where their banner was made)
- Varsity poster – check into making a smaller sized varsity poster in addition to the large sized varsity poster
- Coach Adams proposes a "scholarship" program for players who do not have the means to pay the activity fee, uniform fee, or other expenses related to being a member of a team. Parent may help out with booster club activities to offset a player expenses. Members present agreed to amend our previously approved budget and add \$1200 for scholarship purposes.
- \$2500 approved for Irish stadium improvements has been returned to the booster club. No improvements will be made to the entrance of the stadium at this time.
